

Frequently Asked Questions for Disneyland Adult Junior Golf Tournament

- 1) **What is the golf event format?**
 - a. It is a fun filled two person scramble with a minimum of four drives per team member. Teams will not be flighted but there will be boys and girls divisions.
- 2) **Are handicaps needed?**
 - a. No. They will not be used; this is meant to be a fun day of golf where parents and kids play golf together.
- 3) **What are the age divisions for Boys?** There are no divisions by age, just Boys and Girls
- 4) **Girls?** See above.
- 5) **What are the minimum and maximum ages for the Adult-Junior Open?**
 - a. Juniors are age 8 to 17 years old.
 - b. Adults are ages 21 and older.
- 6) **Is the age pertinent to the time of signup or the actual date of the event?** Day of event.
- 7) **What tees will be played by the adults?** Adults will play each golf course's Mens' Forward tees.
- 8) **What tees will be played by the junior golfers?** Juniors (both boys and girls) will play the Ladies' forward tees.
- 9) **Are carts included with the admission price?** Yes. Each person will get one seat per paid round of golf.
- 10) **Can my child ride in a cart?** Yes as long as a supervising adult drives.
- 11) **Can my child walk?** Yes as long as the golf bag is still strapped to the cart and the supervising adult transports the child in between holes to ensure a proper pace of play.
- 12) **Can my child drive?** No. Not even with a valid driver's license and parental consent.
- 13) **How many places (or %) will qualify for the finals at Tustin Ranch Golf Club?** 30% of the field. Based on 50 teams of 2 or 100 total participants that would equate to 15 total teams of 2 qualifying for the finals. For the finals each Boys and Girls division will have at least two teams make it the finals.
- 14) **How many places/prizes will be awarded?** Every participant will receive a prize. **What are the prizes?** Medals with the higher finishers getting Bronze, Silver and Gold medals.
- 15) **Will there be course contests?** At each facility each day there will be prizes awarded for "Closest to the Pin" for juniors and adults as well as a Long Drive prize for each. **What prizes will be awarded?** At the discretion of Disneyland Resorts.
- 16) **What time is the start each day and is it tee-times or shotgun?** 8am shotgun with everyone teeing off at the same time at different starting holes.
- 17) **When will I find out what my pairings will be?** Pairs will be introduced at the Disney Pairing dinner on Sunday, August 9th at Stage 17 in Disneyland's California Adventure Park.
- 18) **What if I cannot attend the pairings party/ welcome reception at Disneyland's California Adventure Park?** Will not be an issue. You can send someone in your place or simply just be at the assigned course at least 30 minutes before your time the day of play.
- 19) **Can additional family members attend the pairings party/welcome reception and at what cost? Will that be prepaid or can you pay at the door?** Attendees must book the pairing welcome reception in advance through GET Travel Sports. Cost is \$48 per person.
- 20) **Will practice rounds be allowed and at what price?** Yes, each course will be offering discounted rates to the adults and their junior rates to the children. In the case of Black Gold Golf Club the "Resident of Yorba Linda rate" will be extended to the adult. These rates can be found on their website: www.blackgoldgolf.com. Tustin Ranch Golf Club: Juniors \$25 & participating Adult \$75 inc. cart: Mon -Thurs. anytime, & Fri.Sat.Sun. after 12:00 noon.
- 21) **Is any food and beverage included in the cost of the event?** Each day a box lunch will be provided to all participants. Those will be placed on the cart right before play.

- 22) **Do the clubs offer breakfast and at what time?** Yes, beginning at 6am. **Lunch?** Yes, beginning at 12pm (Tustin will serve lunch after 10:30am, but some items earlier on request). The meals will have an additional cost associated with them.
- 23) **Are spectators or caddies allowed?** Yes, but each course has its own policies. At Black Gold all spectators must sign a waiver and rent a cart for \$30 per cart. Tustin Ranch: Spectator or Cart is \$20 per person.
- 24) **Can spectators rent carts to ride around in and watch the event?** Yes. At Black Gold carts can be rented for \$30 per cart. Tustin Ranch: see answer above.
- 25) **Do the golf carts have GPS?** Yes. **What is GPS?** Global positioning system. Gives distance, helpful hints, you can order food, etc. Think an "Electronic Caddy."
- 26) **Are there locker rooms at each of these facilities?** Each course provides different amenities, please call club direct for exact information.
- 27) **Is there a practice range at all three clubs?** Yes there is. Also all three clubs have putting greens and sand bunkers as well for practice. Each day warm up practice range balls are included in the event price.

- 29) **How far away is the golf course from the host hotel?** 7 miles; 15 minutes

- 31) **How far away is the golf course from the host hotel? Miles and estimated minutes?** 11 miles, 25 minutes. Directions can be found on Black Gold's website.

- 33) **How far away is the golf course from the host hotel? Miles and estimated minutes?** 10 miles, 17 minutes
- 34) **Can an adult play with two or more children?** No, this is designed as a One Adult, One Junior type of tournament.
- 35) **Would you say this event is more competitive or fun?** This is first year event where fun will be the main objective. There will be prizes awarded to the best finishers and the last day requires the team to qualify to participate. Fun for the first two days, more competitive the third day for those who enjoy competition.
